This **level 2 NVQ** in Security from Edexcel is suitable for those with the following job titles or similar roles:

- Security Officer
- Door Supervisor
- Retail security officer

The underpinning knowledge course for this NVQ will enable learners to apply for their license whilst completing their full level 2 qualification *please see note below

Funding eligibility

An individual must be aged 19+ to access Train to Gain and meet the Train to Gain eligibility criteria as well as one of the following:

- Be working for an employer under a contract of employment
- Be working as a volunteer for an employer
- Be self-employed
- Be working for an employment agency

and be granted time to train by the employer during working hours
